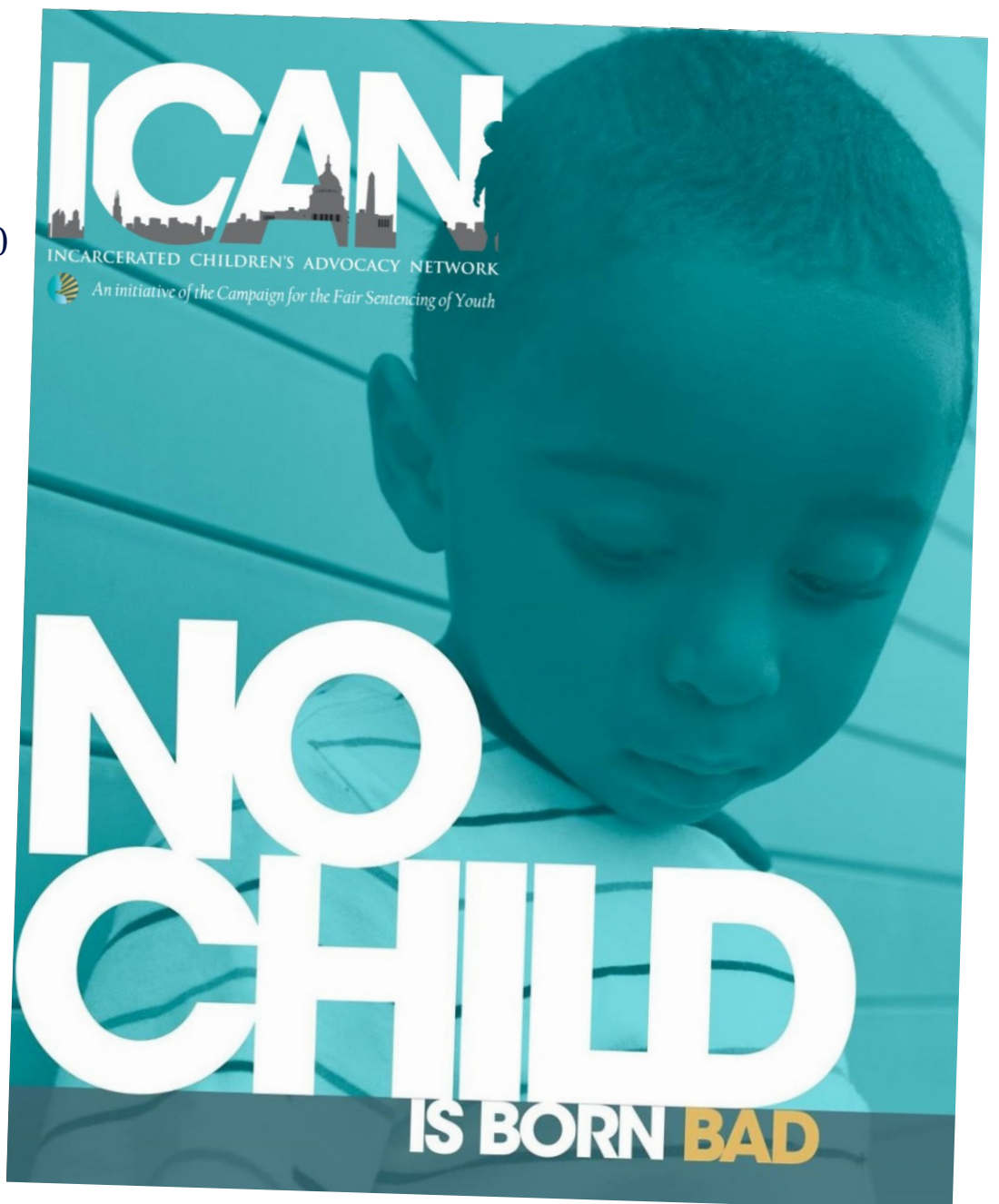
No Child is Born Bad
